**The Rev. Dr. John W. Kleinig** is professor emeritus at Luther College, Adelaide, SA, Australia. He holds the M.A. (1981) and the Ph.D. (1993) from Cambridge University and is the author of numerous articles and books, including two brilliant commentaries: *Leviticus* (CPH, 2003) and *Hebrews* (CPH, 2017). He has also written a masterful study of Christian spirituality, *Grace Upon Grace* (CPH, 2008). Dr. Kleinig serves on DOXOLOGY's Board of Advisors. John and his wife Claire (nee Bentley) have been blessed with four children and ten grandchildren.

**Dr. Adam S. Francisco** is currently Assistant Provost of Mission and Identity and Dean of the College of Theology, Arts & Humanities at Concordia University Chicago.
