Seelsorger is published in the summer of any given year. If you'd like to write for Seelsorger here is an expected timeline for doing so. (The Seelsorger "calendar year," so-to-speak, begins in September and ends in June)

September 30th

Abstract of your proposed essay is due (consult Abstract guidelines).

January 31st

The first draft of your 6,000–9,999 word article is due. (follow *Seelsorger* Style Guide)

February 1st-March 31st

Sometime during the months of February and March your paper will be reviewed by two DOXOLOGY collegium fellows, and a 45–60 minute Zoom conference call will be scheduled with you to discuss the paper.

April 30th

Final draft of the essay is due (and the author's work is done)

May 1st-June 22: Copy-Editing and Layout

June 22: Upload

June 22-July15: Shipment and Review of Proof

July16: Order copies for Grand Reunion any time after this date

Seelsorger seeks to publish 10-12 book reviews a year. Book reviews are due no later than April 15th on any given year. This is a non-negotiable deadline. Any reviews received after April 15th will be included in the following year's volume (be sure to consult Book Review guidelines).
