## A Clear Look at the Landscape of Sexuality and Culture

For each individual with same sex attraction who comes out, a parent, sibling, spouse, or child must respond to new realities. Parents who learn about transgender contagion in their children's school will reel in disbelief, family relationships are often tested mightily, and family members endeavor to respond wisely to the person they love. This presentation will be helpful in providing a candid and compassionate response to the culture's assault on marriage and the family. (Yahnke)

## **Light into Darkness**

The culture is much at work to promote and perpetuate unhealthy sexual behaviors, causing polarization, enmity, and conflict. It's essential to learn how to manage conflict, to lead with wisdom and to be confident and long-suffering instead of quick-tempered.
