

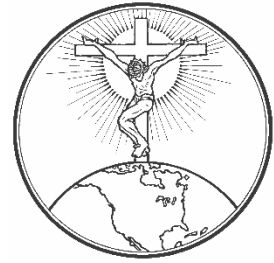
# When I Survey the Wondrous Cross - The Crucifixion in Art
